“Co-Creation for sustainable & circular city development ... Possible?”

Sustainable and circular development (process, budget...) is a challenge, mostly because both companies and governments are not ready for this type of development and cooperation. Co-Creation for sustainable and circular city development, is it possible or not? Thinking of:

- Who is in charge in which part of the cooperation process, where are the limits of participation?
- How can we make the needs and wishes of local networks the point of departure for urban developments (and not the good intentions of administrative or commercial parties)
- Short term: How do we ensure at the end of the day that we realize the project within the set budget?
- Longer term: Can we imagine models of creating and describing values that are broader than conventional purely financial ones?

To build sustainable cities of the future - with happy people - we need cooperation between locals, public, private organizations. But sustainable and circular development is still a challenge...
